**Mandatory Language for Monitoring/Reporting Violation  
Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)  
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR / CHLORINE**

The CITY OF GRANITE SHOALS SHERWOOD SHORES III water system PWS ID 0270022 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water system is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period January 1 to March 31, 2021.

**What We Did: The DLQOR was due on April 10, 2021. We submitted it on May 10, 2021. All disinfection of water before distribution was done to maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system. All monitoring of residuals at various locations within the system was performed and the collection and submittal of samples for microbial analysis was done during the first quarter of 2021. The standards for disinfection and disinfectant residuals were all within regulatory limits during this monitoring period. All microbial samples collected and analyzed during this period were absent from microbial contamination.**
